

Honorees John & Robin Klein

For many years John and Robin shared their time between New York City and the Shore becoming full time residents in 2015 and now reside in Middletown. "We were drawn to the people and the community in Monmouth County and knew this is where we wanted to make our home," said the Klein's.

John, a real estate developer, is Co-Founder and Managing Partner of Thrive LLC and is currently focused on development of supportive housing for neurodiverse adults. John is the former CEO of Simon Premium Outlets, owner and developer of more than 80 outlet malls throughout the US, Canada, Mexico, Japan, South Korea and Malaysia. Robin is president and founder of Fashion Retail Group, a boutique real estate firm providing services for expansion of exclusive retail brands and retail properties.



In addition to their distinguished careers, John and Robin now focus much of their time on philanthropic causes.

"We are so fortunate with time in our schedules to dedicate towards supporting many charitable organizations that speak to our hearts both within our community and beyond". Six years ago, during a trip to Rwanda, John & Robin had the amazing opportunity to tour and become familiar with the Ubumwe Community Center and School in Gisenyi. They have since become actively involved supporting this precious lifeline for the Rwandan people who are so in need of what this center has to offer. In addition, they have a shared, dedicated passion for protecting the environment and saving animals, especially those on the brink of extinction. John & Robin frequently offer their time and support to organizations such as the Dian Fossey Gorilla Fund, Born Free, Monmouth County SPCA, Purr N Pooch Foundation, the Rescue Paw Foundation, No Dogs Left Behind and Partners in Conservation as well as many other welfare groups devoted to improving and saving the lives of animals.

John & Robin's family life is full and busy with five rescue pups who are quite lively; they visit their extended family including John's mother who all live outside of New Jersey as often as possible. They are "aunti and uncle" to MANY of their friends' children and often entertain them at "Kamp Klein"! John and Robin love to travel and are always up for any adventure. They enjoy meeting new people and forging friendships and of course, anything related to ANIMALS. They are often seen out riding their Harleys around the Shore. Honoree Chris Martin

Christopher Martin is executive chairman of Provident Financial Services, Inc. and Provident Bank, New Jersey's oldest state-chartered bank. He has been in the banking industry for more than 38 years.

Accomplish More Together Grants A New Jersey Natural Gas & Monmouth Park Charity Fund Partnership



In 2018 Monmouth Park Charity Fund formed a partnership with New Jersey Natural Gas providing grants to local charities to collaborate on projects that expand service capacity and innovation. This unique funding opportunity called Accomplish More Together, invites charities to form partnerships that by working together they can do more, bringing new solutions to meet the changing needs of our community . Since 2018 this partnership has awarded 16 grants totaling \$95,000 engaging 39 local non-profit organizations and benefiting thousands of Monmouth County residents.

2023 Accomplish More Together Grantees

Girls Scouts of the Jersey Shore with Society for the Prevention of Teen Suicide – Summer Camp Take Over

Girl Scouts of the Jersey Shore will partner with Society for the Prevention of Teen Suicide to bring their signature program, Lead U, to GSJS's Camp Sacajawea for "Summer Camp Take Over". As part of this program, girls will earn GSJS's new Mental Health badge which guides girls to become proficient



in topic areas surrounding mental wellness. Additionally, the partnership will develop materials and trainings for parents, staff, and volunteers of GSJS in their efforts to assist girls in maintaining positive mental health outcomes long after the Summer Camp Take Over concludes. With approximately 160 girls participating during the final week of camp when the "Summer Camp Take Over" will take place, this program will bring leadership training, resiliency skills, and overall mental health support training to a population shown to struggle disproportionately with anxiety and mental health issues. The goal of "Summer Camp Take Over" is to both provide life changing mental health programming to the girls in camp as well as support the framework they will return to once the school year starts.

New Jersey Blind Citizens with Lunchbreak, No Limits Cafe, YMCA, SCAN - Blinds on the GOOOO!

By participating in "Blinds on the G000!" NJBCA members will broaden their life and learning experiences and provide them with the opportunity to have new and interesting interactions and conversations with their families, caregivers and people in the community. Partnering with other area charities, we will



continue to work with Lunchbreak on providing free meals and fresh vegetables for our Campers to take home with them; No Limits Cafe to provide our Campers with lunch and activities as well as a different place to visit and learn, at YMCA in Red Bank we will rent aquatic space for our members to participate in water aerobics and be part of the national initiative of the Council for the Blind to get blind and visually impaired more active and healthier. At SCAN we will integrate our members into some of their wonderful programs, all to provide creative and educational programs for our Campers and to reduce isolation.

Social Justice at Trinity with EM-power me...

will facilitate "Remote Employment for Individuals Re-entering the Workforce". This pilot project will give unemployed formerly incarcerated people opportunities to attain remote employment by providing basic computer training and access to a shared workspace with necessary equipment (computer, internet access, desk). EM-POWER ME works with clients that were formerly incarcerated. Social Justice at Trinity works with clients experiencing homelessness or



housing instability, many of whom were formerly incarcerated. Our goal is to team up to provide our clients a secure and safe location with required equipment to learn basic computer and remote work skills. Participants will benefit from receiving job coaching and training to help them come up to speed with commonly used software that will lead to confidence and competencies for employment. One employed our counselors will also help with housing and overcoming other re-entry hurdles. Participants will have a counselor to work with to mitigate obstacles to becoming successfully reintegrated into their community.

Winners Circle Society

This annual grant opportunity is funded through the collective donations and vision of the MPCF Winners Circle Society members. One grant is allocated each year. Inspired by Monmouth Park Charity Fund's 75 year legacy of raising and distributing critically need funds to local charities, the Winners Circle Society are individuals dedicated to the health and well-being of our community, and to the mission of Monmouth Park Charity Fund. Members, through the collective power of combined donations, influence creative and transformational funding pathways to meet the changing needs of Monmouth County Residents. Together we transform lives.

Mercy Center awarded 2023 Winner's Circle Grant



Providing free tax preparation, "...this program will help thousands of working poor individuals and families get back hundreds of thousands of dollars that will help them in their day-to-day lives and allow them to get their car repaired, buy more food, help pay their rent, cover medical bills, etc."

Members make an annual donation of \$500 or more designated to the Winners Circle Society. Donations raised through this Society are split into two revenue streams. Half of the funds raised will go to MPCF sustaining funds and the other half is placed into the WCS Transformational Grant Fund. Members are invited to participate in determining how the grant funds are distributed.
