




Honorees Cyndi and Glen Dalakian

Raised in a family-owned Dry Cleaning operation, Glen J. Dalakian, Sr. learned the power of small business at a very young age. After attending Seton Hall University, he developed a variety of enterprises in the electronics, entertainment and retail industries, generating millions of dollars in revenue in various niche markets. In addition to owning several companies, Glen is a writer and author with a monthly column "Business Matters" published in the Journal Magazines and a new book about to be released. He currently serves as President of the Board at Colts Neck Community Church and sits on the board of several organizations including the Colts Neck Business Association, of which he is a Founding Member and past



President. Glen is known for his commitment to God, dedication to his family, philanthropy throughout the community and his enthusiasm for business.

For the last 41 years, Glen has been with the "love of his life," Cyndi, and they look forward to celebrating their 37th wedding anniversary in May. Early on when the Covid Pandemic hit hardest, Glen and Cyndi founded Gathering Gifts to Give, an organization dedicated to raising money and distributing resources to families, first responders and medical personnel during the health crisis. 


The Maddy Massabni Foundation for Menstrual Toxic Shock Awareness





### Accomplish More Together Grants A New Jersey Natural Gas/ Monmouth Park Charity Fund Partnership



In 2018 Monmouth Park Charity Fund formed a partnership with New Jersey Natural Gas providing grants to local charities to collaborate on projects that expand service capacity and innovation. This unique funding opportunity called, Accomplish More Together, invites charities to form partnerships that achieve more together, bringing new solutions to meet the changing needs of our community. Since 2018, this partnership has awarded 19 grants totaling \$125,000 engaging 57 local non-profit organizations and benefiting thousands of Monmouth County residents.

ty. The Community Food Connection has partnered with a fifth generation New Jersey farm, Fernbrook Farms, to connect 350 families with a consistent supply of local, naturally-grown, fresh seasonal produce this growing season. Each of the 13 partners are food distribution sites. In essence, they receive the food from Fernbrook Farms and distribute it to 350 families on select days and times weekly.

#### Mental Health Association of Monmouth County

(MHAMC) (Mental Health and youth) and Konkret Comics (KC), Monmouth County Diversity Alliance (MCDA) - *The time for comics is NOW* – Daring to be different, MHAMC and KC created the first of its kind educational comic book series for high school aged youth that focuses on increasing awareness of mental health and wellness, reducing stigma, encouraging support seeking behaviors and strengthening



communication between caregivers and their children. This educational comic book series will be distributed to all forty-two (42) Monmouth High Schools, reaching 34,000 students. The comic book topics will address depression and anxiety, substance use, transgender and LGBTQ+, bullying, peer pressure, gang involvement, and stigmas that come along with all of the above. The launch of K-Way High comic book will be featured at MHAMC's 2nd Annual Be YourSELF Showcase on May 10, 2024.



Monmouth Arts Council (homelessness) and HABcore - Creative Expressions Arts and Wellness Program. This collaborative and innovative project will benefit Monmouth County residents who have experienced homelessness. Additionally, the program will help to raise awareness about the issue of homelessness in our community. The program will utilize the power of the arts to impact the lives of 50 adult residents in HABcore's Adult Congregate Living Program located in Red Bank and Asbury Park. It will offer a unique opportunity for the residents to participate in structured art classes for an extended period. This in-home program elimi-

nates transportation and will be tailored to the resident's abilities. The Program will run for eight weeks in HABcore's Red Bank and Asbury Park homes, once in the spring and once in the fall. The Program will enhance the residents' mental and social well-being through visual arts activities and self-expression. A team of teaching artists and mental health professionals will create and lead the art activities, providing individuals with opportunities for creative exploration, socialization, inspiration, and relaxation.

### Winners Circle Society

This annual grant opportunity is funded through the collective donations and vision of the MPCF Winners Circle Society members. One grant is allocated each year. Inspired by Monmouth Park Charity Fund's 76 year legacy of raising and distributing critically need funds to local charities, the Winners Circle Society are individuals dedicated to the health and well-being of our community, and to the mission of Monmouth Park Charity Fund. Members, through the collective power of combined donations, influence creative and transformational funding pathways to meet the changing needs of Monmouth County Residents. Together we transform lives.

On September 11, 2023 a \$21,750 grant was awarded to the Asbury Park Music Foundation (APMF) to expand their "Music Saved My Life" program to Red Bank, marking the Winners Circle Society's fourth year of giving.

APMF's decade of success in Asbury Park led to a natural expansion into Red Bank through partnerships with Red Bank Charter School and the Boys & Girls Club. For the past 10 years, APMF and Lakehouse Music

Academy have established a successful model for Music Saved My Life. APMF places Lakehouse teachers in local schools, where they teach music classes during the school day, and at Boys & Girls Clubs for after-school music enrichment. APMF built a hip hop studio at the Asbury Park Boys & Girls Club and is expanding its involvement at the Red Bank Club. APMF pays for the teachers to provide music education in these schools and community locations.



Students follow a progressive music curriculum and proceed at their own pace, developing into well-rounded musicians with proper technique, knowledge of their instrument and practical performance skills. We measure student progress in accordance with this curriculum. Most importantly, APMF amplifies young voices by offering students a safe space to be themselves, brayely and unapologetically. In addition, teachers see the students continuously throughout the school year and build an emotional connection that goes far beyond music. They become trusted mentors. If a student says they need help with math, or food for their family, or are being bullied online, our teachers spring into action.

Members make an annual donation of \$500 or more designated to the Winners Circle Society. Donations raised through this Society are split into two revenue streams. Half of the funds raised will go to MPCF sustaining funds and the other half is placed into the WCS Transformational Grant Fund. Members are invited to participate in determining how the grant funds are distributed.
