Lawrence R. Inserra, Jr. is Chairman & CEO of Inserra Supermarkets, Inc., one of the largest family-owned and operated supermarket chains in the metropolitan area.

Inserra Supermarkets has been family owned for four generations, and the stores have been rooted in the New Jersey community since 1954. Founded by Larry's grandfather, Patsy Inserra, the first store was located in Lyndhurst, New Jersey.

Larry was named Chairman and CEO of Inserra Supermarkets in 2015 and the company has grown

significantly under his direction. The company currently employs more than 4,200 associates, continues to invest in current store locations, and has plans to expand their family business with new store openings in the next few years. Inserra Supermarkets currently owns and operates twenty-four ShopRite Stores, two Fresh Grocer Stores and two PriceRite Marketplace stores in Bergen, Hudson and Passaic Counties in New Jersey and Rockland County and Brooklyn in New York.

Larry is a devoted steward of his family's tradition of always lending a helping hand to those in need. Under his guidance, the company continues to expand community partnerships and provides funding and support to hundreds of charitable and local organizations, including hospitals, schools, community wellness programs, and local chapters of civic and veterans' groups.

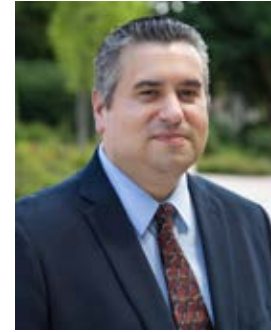
He also serves as a trustee for The Inserra Family Foundation which hosts the Carl Inserra Memorial Golf Outing Fundraiser in memory of the late Carl Inserra. He currently serves as the Chairman of both the Hackensack Meridian Health Foundation & Hackensack Meridian Health Carrier Clinic. Larry was born in Newark and raised in Rutherford, NJ. He attended Lehigh University where he earned a Bachelor of Science degree in business and economics. He and his wife Inez reside in Mahwah, NJ.

David Stout, Ph.D., earned a Bachelor's degree in Psychology, a Masters in Psychological Counseling, and a Doctorate in Health Psychology and Behavioral Medicine.

Before becoming Brookdale Community College's seventh president, Dr. Stout served the institution for more than 25 years in leadership, teaching, and counseling roles, including Vice President for Student Success, Dean of the Freehold Campus, Professor and

Department Chair of Psychology and Human Services, and Counselor. He also taught at Rutgers University and Monmouth University and published research on opioid dependence and workplace abuse.

Dr. Stout has served on the Monmouth County Mental Health Board and the Human Services Needs Assessment Steering Committee.

As president, Dr. Stout emphasizes community well-being, helping to launch the KEYS Academy Recovery High School, the Nutrition Hub Food Pantry, the Caroline Huber Holistic Wellness Center, and the Achieve Academy for Adults with Autism. He is a member of the Economic Mobility Committee of the New Jersey Community College Presidents Council and the statewide NJ JOBS Committee focusing on helping probation clients find meaningful work. His mantra is "Community is our Middle Name," and he is committed to expanding access to education, health, and social services through strong community partnerships.

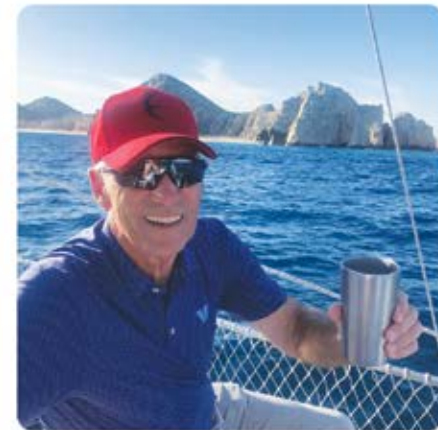

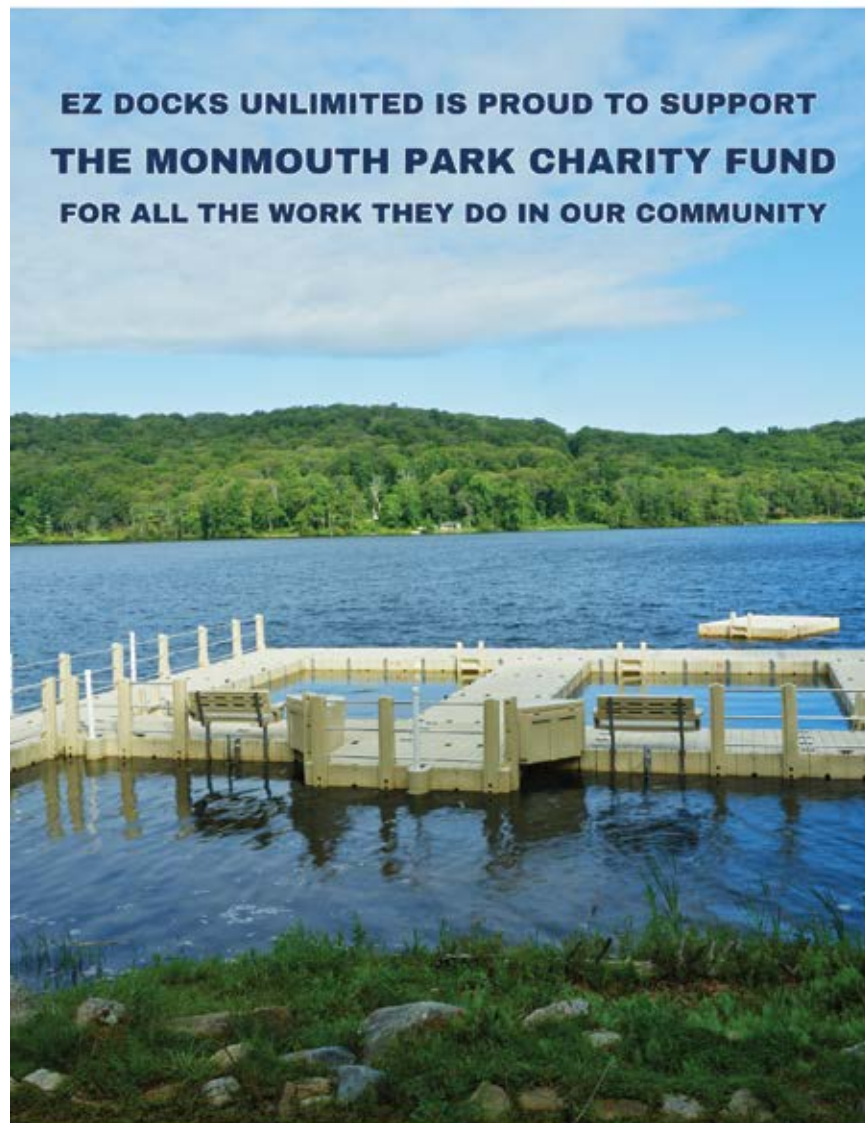

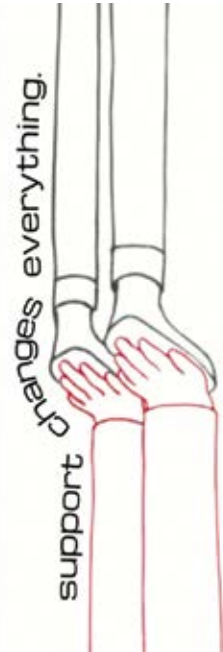

In 2018, Monmouth Park Charity Fund formed a partnership with New Jersey Natural Gas providing grants to local charities to collaborate on projects that expand service capacity and innovation. This unique funding opportunity called, “Accomplish More Together”, invites nonprofits to form partnerships that achieve more together, bringing new solutions to meet the challenging needs of our community. Since 2018, this partnership has awarded 25 grants totaling \$185,000, engaging 63 local nonprofit organizations and benefiting thousands of Monmouth County residents.

2026 Accomplish More Together Grantees



180 Turning Lives Around and Pinwheel Place

Removing Barriers to Justice: Childcare Support for Survivors – 180 Turning Lives Around, in partnership with Pinwheel Place will expand this collaborative childcare support initiative. The program assists survivors of domestic violence navigating the Monmouth County court system. Through this partnership, survivors connected to 180’s Family Justice Center, will be referred to Pinwheel Place for safe, trauma-informed childcare, during court appearances—at no cost—helping to remove a critical barrier to accessing justice.



Common Ground Grief Center, Stephy’s Place, LEAD U, and other local organizations

Language of Loss: Creating a Grief-Positive Culture – This initiative aims to increase awareness of childhood bereavement and foster more grief-sensitive school communities. The program includes an assembly-style presentation that explores grief through vignettes, followed by a question-and-answer session with bereaved youth to reinforce key learning objectives. The goal is to introduce a dynamic, hands-on learning experience in area schools.



We Are Loved and Fostering Farmers

Growing Together: A Trauma-Informed Garden and Life Skills Program for Foster Youth – This collaborative initiative uses hands-on gardening, food education, and basic meal preparation to build confidence, strengthen connections, and promote practical life skills. By combining trauma-informed youth engagement with agricultural education and experiential learning, the program creates a holistic pilot model that neither organization could deliver independently. Programming emphasizes responsibility, patience, and a sense of belonging while offering positive, consistent experiences for youth who often face instability.

Winner's Circle Society

This annual grant opportunity is funded through the collective donations and vision of the MPCF Winner's Circle Society members. Inspired by Monmouth Park Charity Fund's 78 year legacy of raising and distributing critically needed funds to local charities, the Winner's Circle Society are individuals dedicated to the health and well-being of our community, and to the mission of Monmouth Park Charity Fund. Members, through the collective power of combined donations, influence creative and transformational funding pathways to meet the changing needs of Monmouth County Residents. Together we transform lives.



On Thursday, August 28th, the members of the Winner's Circle awarded a \$20,000 grant to Parker Family Health Center.

In collaboration with Brookdale Community College, Parker Family Health Center is launching a free dental clinic to serve uninsured and under-resourced Monmouth County residents. Located on the Brookdale campus, the clinic will be the first of its kind in New Jersey, with an anticipated opening in Spring 2026. The grant will support the delivery of no-cost dental care, as well as the development of a dental hygiene certification program—the only one currently offered in Monmouth County.

Members make an annual donation of \$500 or more designated to the Winner's Circle Society. Donations raised through this Society are split into two revenue streams.
